#### RiskCause Analysis Workshop - August 23, 2024

We had a successful and insightful **RiskCause Analysis Workshop** with members of the ASSP Greater Baton Rouge Chapter! The session focused on a critical shift in safety management—moving from "preventing recurrence" to "managing risk." By analyzing the root causes of incidents, we emphasized how understanding and managing potential risks can be far more effective than merely addressing past incidents.

One of the highlights was the debut of our innovative *Prevention Gauge* tool. This tool empowers teams to measure the likelihood of the effectiveness of their corrective actions by asking the right questions, assessing the probability and severity of risks, and ensuring solutions are SMART and align with the Hierarchy of Risk Treatment. As one attendee noted, "the concept of rating corrective actions for effectiveness will directly affect how I craft correction actions."

Attendees enjoyed the new insights and perspectives, with one saying it provided "both a good overview of incident investigations and an introduction of higher-level, newer concepts." Attendees left the workshop with practical strategies for integrating risk management into their safety protocols, leading to safer workplaces and more proactive safety cultures.
